The Tamil Nadu Animal Welfare Board (TNAWB), under the Department of Animal Husbandry, Government of Tamil Nadu, is establishing 6 Animal Shelters for abandoned, rescued, and injured animals under the Vallalar Palluyir Kappagangal Scheme.

In order to ensure humane, professional, and transparent shelter management, Expression of Willingness (EoW) is hereby invited from eligible and experienced Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) / Animal Welfare Organisations (AWOs) for undertaking the maintenance and management of the above-mentioned shelters.

REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

All NGOs/AWOs selected for managing Government-assisted shelters must:

1. Obtain registration from the Tamil Nadu Animal Welfare Board (TNAWB).
2. Obtain recognition from the Animal Welfare Board of India (AWBI), wherever applicable (optional).

SECTION C: PROPOSED SHELTER MAINTENANCE PLAN

C1. Understanding of the Assignment

The shelter is exclusively meant for housing abandoned, rescued, injured, and ferocious/community animals requiring segregation and care.

C2. Infrastructure Maintenance Plan

SECTION D: RESPONSIBILITIES OF NGO / AWO

The selected NGO/AWO shall undertake the following responsibilities:

1. To manage, operate, and maintain the Animal Shelter strictly in accordance with the guidelines issued by TNAWB and applicable legal provisions under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960.
2. To ensure proper day-to-day shelter management including humane handling, feeding, watering, sanitation, hygiene, and biosecurity.
3. To coordinate with the Veterinarians deputed by the Regional Joint Director (RJD), Animal Husbandry Department, who shall oversee medical care and emergency treatment at the shelter.
4. After admission of animals, ensure that sterilization of eligible dogs is carried out only at nearby ABC Centres run by the Animal Husbandry Department, based on examination and fitness certification by the Veterinarian deputed at the shelter. After completion of post-operative care, the NGO/AWO shall arrange for safe transport of the animals back to the shelter.
5. To maintain proper records including intake register, treatment register, feeding register, medicine stock register, mortality register, and financial records.
6. To extend full cooperation to inspections conducted by TNAWB, RJD, District Animal Welfare Officer (DAWO), and other authorized officials.
7. To coordinate with Local Bodies for rescue and management of abandoned/injured animals.

8. To ensure uninterrupted shelter services at all times.
9. To strictly comply with all directions issued by TNAWB and the Animal Husbandry Department.
10. To ensure uninterrupted services. In case of delay in release of funds, the NGO/AWO shall make necessary interim arrangements to management of shelter

SECTION E: MANPOWER STRUCTURE

The manpower for maintenance of each shelter shall be as follows:

- Four (4) Animal Handlers
- One (1) Cook

The above manpower shall be deployed and paid by the Tamil Nadu Animal Welfare Board (TNAWB).

Additionally:

- The NGO/AWO shall, engage night-shift animal handlers using the sanctioned running cost provided by TNAWB.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE

1. TNAWB shall provide financial assistance towards:
 - Animal feed
 - Operational and running expenses of the shelter
2. The NGO/AWO shall utilize the funds strictly for the sanctioned purpose.
3. Proper accounts, stock registers, and supporting records shall be maintained and produced for verification.
4. Release of subsequent funds shall be subject to submission of Utilization Certificates and satisfactory performance.

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

Eligible NGOs/AWOs must:

- Be registered under relevant Acts (Trust/Society/Section 8 Company)
- Have prior experience in animal welfare or shelter management
- Be recognized by TNAWB
- Agree to inspection, audit, and reporting requirements
- Not have any pending legal dispute or litigation against TNAWB
- Not have any pending FIR or criminal case related to animal welfare activities or financial irregularities
- Submit a self-declaration to this effect

SECTION F: DECLARATION

I/We hereby declare that:

1. The information furnished above is true and correct.
2. We agree to comply with all TNAWB guidelines and applicable legal provisions.
3. We understand that selection is subject to scrutiny and approval by TNAWB.
